ONE-TO-ONE SPECIFIC ISSUE TRAINING

Each dog and family is unique and even though some behaviour actions are common amongst dogs, it is the individuality of the environment that the dog is living in that makes any issue personal.

For specific general obedience issues a half hour lesson may be all that you need; a specific issue generally includes any of the following but you may have something else that you are wanting to get on top of so please contact us to discuss:

- · Walking on a loose lead
- Teaching the dog to sit
- Teaching the dog to lay down
- Teaching good manners in greeting (both dogs and people)
- Coming when called
- Not chasing bicycles or joggers
- House training
- · Good house manners
- Calming over-excitement
- Overcoming some fear issues if fear is extreme then a behaviour consultation may be necessary
- · Learning to leave things alone
- Calming over-vocalisation/barking
- Retrieving

For anything else a behavioural consultation may be required (if there are multiple issues to work through) - please contact us to discuss.

Most of the training can happen at either your place or ours but it does depend on what the issue is that you want resolved; sometimes it is easier for us to come to your home to witness your dog in their normal daily routine and circumstances; at other times, we can discuss the issue and work out a plan at either the Its the Dogs consulting room in West Molesey or at our private training venue in West Horsley or even conduct some training on local parks. It may be that once you've had a one to one training lesson that you feel more comfortable joining a <u>class</u> or you can continue with more individual lessons or you might feel that you have gained enough knowledge in the one session - whatever you want to do it is your choice. In some circumstances we can even carry on the training for you by training the required behaviours then teaching you.
