

## Doggy Daycare Application Form

We want all of our guests to get the most enjoyment that they can in coming to our doggy daycare. It is important to us that they are all comfortable and interact in suitable groups that they make or have friends in. Most of our guests get to enjoy being in an indoor venue during part of the day as well as the opportunity to run free within parts of our 27 acres of privately owned land. As well as the doggy and human interaction that our guests receive, we also provide enrichment in the form of toys and treats. Our team includes behaviourists and trainers but everyone looking after our guests is trained in the best care and management of dogs, including canine first aid training.

This application form will give us an idea of whether we can take the first steps of your dog trialling our environment, most dogs love it but there are some who don't thrive. Please be honest, dogs are living beings and like us humans each of them has their own individual personality; what you may think is unwanted behaviour we may find is pretty normal. Dogs can act quite differently away from their owner's environment. Answering the questions below will help us determine whether your dog could be suitable and whether any unique personality traits are manageable within our environment.

Once you have filled in and returned this application form we will come and meet you and your four-legged friend so that you can also make sure that we are suitable for you. You are also more than welcome to check out our premises; our indoor venue in West Molesey has limited spaces which is why we need to make sure your dog will be comfortable here; and our outdoor venue in West Horsley can easily be seen from the gate (or rented privately-ask us how) just ask us for directions.

We will then ask you to complete an enrolment form which gives us a few more details and we will then discuss with you your dog's first visit.

## Terms and Conditions

1. All dogs need to wear flat collars for safety reasons, and have an attached nametag. Collars need to be of a type which can be cut off in an emergency.
2. Your dog needs to have up-to-date vaccinations; puppies that have had their first vaccination are able to attend Doggy Daycare, however you accept the risk and that Its The Dogs is not liable for consequences. If your dog is sick, you must let your dog attend Doggy Daycare for the safety of other dogs. If your dog is suffering from a contagious disease, your dog will not attend until he/she has been cleared by a practicing veterinarian saying they are safe to attend. You understand Its The Dogs may need to separate your dog from other dogs if they believe your dog may have a transmittable disease, and that they will contact you to let you know.
3. Whilst all care will be taken to ensure the health and safety of your dog, you understand dogs may incur the occasional muscle soreness, injury, or mild contagion. When you leave your dog with Its The Dogs, you acknowledge the possibility of this happening and accept that Its The Dogs will not be liable for any costs associated with these. If Its The Dogs believes your dog needs veterinary care they will make every effort to contact you. If there is an emergency, they will take your dog to the closest available vet clinic.
4. Its The Dogs recommends that you keep a regular programme of treatment for internal and external parasites (for example, fleas, ticks and worms).
5. I understand Its The Dogs reserves the right to decline your dog from Doggy Daycare. Your dog needs to meet requirements for reasonably good manners and may not be admitted to the general Doggy Daycare area unless discussed earlier with Its The Dogs. This is in order to provide safety for all dogs who attend.
6. Due to hygiene and safety reasons, bitches in season will not be able to attend Doggy Daycare. If Its The Dogs feels your dog has behavioural problems they will let you know and discuss available options regarding training etc to help overcome these issues.
7. You have provided a description in the space above of any health or behavioural problems your dog has. Examples of health/medical problems can be but are not limited to allergies, arthritis, or epilepsy. It is important Its The Dogs are informed of these due to the safety of your dog and other dogs, and because they may provide treats to attending dogs.

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Its The Dogs may wish to use images/videos of my pet taken in Doggy Daycare. They use these on their website, publications, and for learning purposes. Working with animals means that we can't always control who ends up in the images. We ensure that any dog's full identities are never disclosed but if your dog is accepted for Doggy Daycare we will give you the option on the enrolment form should you NOT wish for us to identify you dog in these.

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
